



Senior Assessment Appraiser

The City of Regina is looking to fill the position of a Senior Property Appraiser within the Property Assessment Services Branch. The position will primarily focus on research and regression modelling including statistical analysis in the preparation of residential and non-residential valuation models. This position reports to the Manager of Research and Appeals.

The knowledge, skills and abilities required through completion of a university degree in Computer Science, Data Management, Statistics or Mathematics combined with five (5) years of professional experience in a related field. Completion of the Saskatchewan Assessment Appraiser Association's designation program or licensed or certified through the Saskatchewan Assessment Appraiser Association.

OR

The knowledge, skills and abilities required through completion of a university degree in Economics or Commerce, supplemented with the first and second level of the Appraisal Institute of Canada's courses or possession of the Appraisal Institute of Canada's AACI designation or the International Association of Assessing Officers CAE designation combined with a minimum of five (5) years professional experience in commercial property valuation. Completion of the Saskatchewan Assessment Appraiser Association's designation program or licensed or certified through the Saskatchewan Assessment Appraiser Association.
